**9. COMPETITORS**

*PLEASE NOTE:* Single Event Driver & Navigators Licence may be used for Multi Club and State Championship Sections. *HOWEVER* Event Secretary must be notified prior to event .

**12. RECONNAISSANCE**

Competitors wanting to reconnoitre the course must fill in the 'Reconnaissance Application Form' and return with entry form (No Reconnaissance Application Form/No Reconnaissance). Competitors reconnoitring the course must be lined up in the pits from 9.40 am. If you are not lined up by 10.00 am you will not be able to reconnoitre the course Reconnaissance will be led by the Stewards of the Meeting. **Reconnaissance of the course in road registered non-competition 4WD's only commencing at 10.00 am**

**15. REFUELLING**

Refuelling during the race can only be carried out in the pits or refuelling lane provided. Occupants must be out of the vehicle, motor switched off and have a fire extinguisher at hand before fuel tank caps and/or fuel container caps can be removed. Refuelling can only take place from containers of not more than 20 litres capacity. All containers must be effectively sealed until needed for immediate use to prevent spillage. All containers must be effectively sealed or removed before the crew may re-enter the vehicle. Refuelling in areas other than the pits or refuelling lane will only be permitted if permission is obtained from the Clerk of Course and carried out under the direction and supervision of a fire extinguisher equipped recovery vehicle crew. Refer SR 4-6 (Refuelling) of the 2009 CAMS Manual.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

Breathalyzer equipment may be in attendance and breath testing may occur during this event.
